50% of total seats in MCA (2 year) course are set apart for centralized Allotment by the Govt. of Kerala, which will notified by the Government.


2. Management Quota

Admission to management seats are conducted by the Management. Admission is strictly on the basis of merit.

How to apply for Management Quota Admission?

- ➤ Visit the website http://admission.fisat.ac.in and submit applications ONLINE
- Applications should be complete in all respects. A candidate will be considered for admission, only if he/she has furnished the relevant certificates prescribed in the Prospectus, in proof of eligibility.
- During the online application process, the candidate is required to fill the form online using the link given above, pay the application fees of Rs. 350 (Netbanking/Debit card/Credit card), update the marks when available, and upload the necessary documents.





General Instructions

- a) Candidate should submit applications inonline from the college website for management quota / lapsed seats.
- b) Passport size photograph should be uploaded in the online application.
- c) Applications should be complete in all respects. A candidate will be considered for admission, only if he/she has furnished the relevant certificates prescribed in the prospectus, in proof of eligibility or in support of any claim for reservation, under any category.
- d) Documents or certificates furnished after submission of the application will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- e) All basic information required is to be filled in with utmost care. The data provided in the offline application will be used for processing the application.
- f) Any error in filling the online application or providing false/incomplete/wrong information will affect the candidates' eligibility for admission or claim for reservation under any category. Furnishing false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as the cancellation of admission at any stage, even after admission.
- g) Candidates are advised to keep a copy of completed application form for further reference.

8. Procedure of Selection

1. Government Quota

50% of the sanctioned intake of the MCA programme will be filled by the Govt. as per the notification of admission to MCA Course.

2. Management Quota

- Rank list will be prepared giving weightage to marks obtained in degree examinations
- b. Merit list for the admission will be published in the website. Selection will be in the order of merit through open counseling. The date for counseling will be informed through the website.
- c. Candidates are advised to visit the website of the college regularly to get updated information on interview and admission etc. No separate communication will be sent on this account.



- d. Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the college, after paying the tuition fee and other fees to be paid, failing which the offer of admission will be cancelled.
- e. For genuine reasons, Management will have the right to deny admission to any candidate, even if otherwise eligible and such reasons will recorded and told to the student.

9. Eligibility for MCA Admission

✓ Candidates should have passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree

OR

- ✓ Passed B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or atGraduation Level (with additional bridge Courses as per the norms of the concerned University).
- ✓ Candidates should have obtained at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying examination.
- ✓ Must qualify entranceexamination conducted by a competent authority as per the rules and regulations of APJ/AICTE/Govt.

10.Documents Required

11. Important Dates for issue of applications: -

Management Quota applications will be issued immediately after the publication of qualifying examination results. For Government Quota allotment, processes are scheduled by the dates as decided by Government

12. Refund / Adjustment of Fees

If a candidate leaves the college after taking admission he/she will be liable topay liquated damages, subject to the approval of ASC.

17. Examinations

Two-yearMCA Course extends over a period of two years comprising four semesters. Curriculum of the programme followed is as prescribed by KTU. University examinations will be held at the end of each semester. There will be internal examinations conducted by the institution to assess the progress and to assign sessional marks, as per the scheme and syllabi.





18. Placement and Training Cell (PTC)


20. Community Services

21. Caution against Ragging
